Window Security Screens Installation Guide

Installation Steps:

Note: Screens can be installed directly into brick, wood and stucco.


Top Hinged Screen - Screw placement across top hinge panel only. Uses slide-bolt closure. Slide-bolts click into the window track, no additional interior installation required. *(see Top Hinge caption)*

Fixed Screen - Screw placement, all the way around the subframe. Fixed screens are screwed into place, non-operable and will not have spring-loaded slide-bolts. (see Fixed Screen caption)


Screens with Subframe - Screw placement, all the way around the subframe. Screens with Subframe are operable with interior spring-loaded slide-bolts. (see Subframe caption)



Non-corrosive, spring-loaded slide-bolts to securely latch for operable Top Hinged and Subframe Screens.









Without Subframe (showing top hinge)


Note: All top hinge Screens without **subframe** have slide-bolt closure that latches inside window track. All Screens with **subframe slide-bolt closure** lock into subframe. Fixed Screens do not have slide-bolt closure.
